The program features comprehensive guided tours to the vineyards, Lagares (traditional wine-pressers) and lodges; introduction to the art of fine winemaking presented by the “Quinta” – Wine producing Estate - owner or wine-makers and a pic-nic lunch near the river. Arrival to Porto around 6 p.m.
