### Abstract Submission Guidelines

*We encourage work that introduces new ideas and conceptualizations, research and understandings to the field, as well as analysis/reflections/perceptions of nursing students about the theme.*

*Please read the following guidelines carefully before submitting your abstract:*

#### 1- REGISTRATION

- Before submit an abstract, please confirm that you are registered.
- All the authors agree with this guidelines
- The scientific committee will not accept more than **three** abstracts of the same author.
- **Nurses, teachers, researchers and post graduate students** are invited to submit abstracts to COMMUNICATION.
- **Undergraduate Students** are invited to submit their perceptions, reflections or ideas about the theme of the conference, individually or in group. They should present only as a POSTER.

## 2- COMMUNICATIONS

(If you are a nurse, teacher, researcher, post graduate student)

### 2.1 - ABSTRACT STRUCTURE

- 1 page A4 (editable format)
- English language
- 400 words
- Single spaced
- Font size: 12 pt (text), 14 pt (title)
- Font Type: Arial
- 2,5 cm margins on all sides
- The name of the document should be the title of the abstract, no spaces or accents
- Heading should include: title of the communication, author(s) name, author(s) affiliation, E-mail address of principal author.

### 2.2 – PRESENTATION

- The communication should be presented in 10 minutes in English language.
- Computer and data show will be available
- Stay at the room after your communication to participate at the final discussion in order to answer some questions that may arise and contribute to the objectives of the conference.

## 3- ABSTRACT STRUCTURE FOR POSTERS

(If you are an **undergraduate student**)

### 3.1 – ABSTRACT STRUCTURE

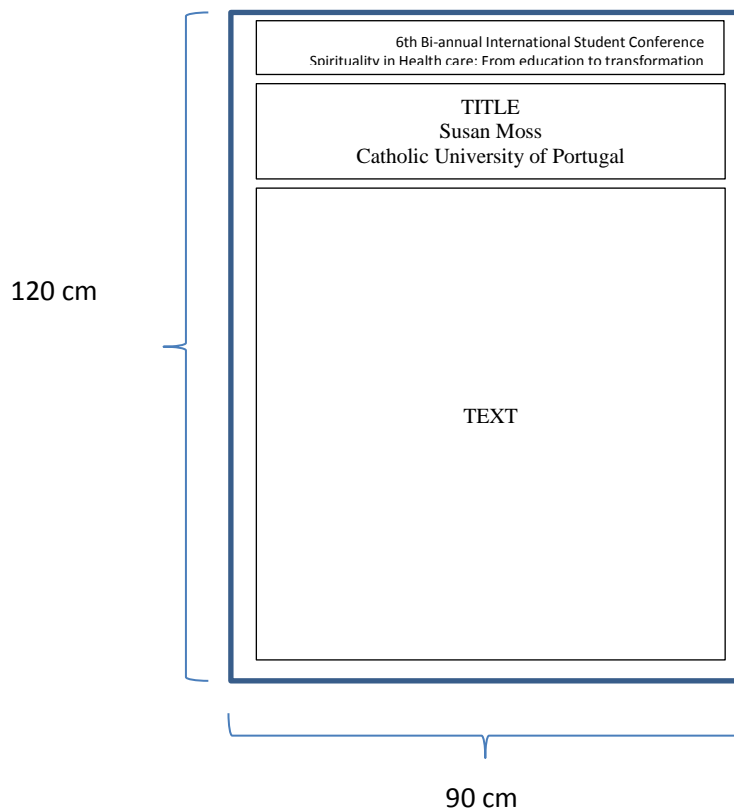
- Poster in 1 page A4 size.

### 3.2 – PRESENTATION

- Dimension for posters are: 120 cm high by 90 cm wide (vertical)
- Poster printed on a single paper in English language.
- Place the title of the conference at right top of the poster (see figure below).
- Place the title at the top of the poster board to allow viewers to identify (Capital letters) followed by the authors' names and the institution.

- Organize the text on the poster board so it is clear, orderly, and self-explanatory. You have complete freedom in displaying your information in figures, tables, text, photographs, etc.
- Use squares, rectangles or circles to group similar ideas. Avoid cluttering your poster with too much text. Label different elements as I, II, III; or 1, 2, 3; or A, B, C, making it easier for a viewer to follow your display.
- Presenters are responsible for bringing general supplies such as push pins, tape and scissors.
- Posters **must** be placed and removed by presenters. Posters remaining after the time of exposure will be removed and recycled.
- The presenters will be informed about the time schedule of the poster exposure.
